AWARDS:

Make sure you enter your dog's qualifications so that preference can be correctly taken into account. In particular, **FTCh alone is NOT a qualification**

If you have a FTCh you must enter at least **one** qualifying award, either on the paper entry form, or into the Fosse Data System by clicking 'Add Award'. Dogs who's awards have not been entered may be entered into the incorrect draw preference.

DRAW: The draw will be done by the Fosse Data system on
Wednesday 5 August 2026 at 1pm.

The result of the draw will be communicated to all entrants by email. Entrants may contact the Field Trial Secretary after 3pm on the date of the draw or anytime during office hours thereafter.

RULES AND REGULATIONS.

- 1 Dogs entered at Royal Kennel Club Licensed Field Trials must be registered at the Kennel Club in accordance with Royal Kennel Club Regulations for Classification and Registration B.
- 2 The Royal Kennel Club reserves the right to refuse any entry.
- 3 Substitution of dogs is permitted.
- 4 All dogs resident outside the UK must be issued with a Royal Kennel Club Authority to Compete number before entry to the show/event can be made.
- 5 If entries or nominations exceed the number of permitted runners, the right to compete in a Trial shall be decided by ballot.
- 6 Should circumstances so dictate the Society, in consultation with the judges, may alter arrangements as necessary. Such changes and the circumstances surrounding them will be reported to the Royal Kennel Club.
- 7 No modification may be made to the schedule after publication except by permission of the Royal Kennel Club, followed by advertisement in appropriate journals if time permits before the closing of entries.
- 8 Judges at a Trial are prohibited from entering a dog which is recorded in their ownership or part ownership.
- 9 Videography and photography will only be permitted with the express agreement of the Chief Steward and the Host.
- 10 **Welfare of Dogs**
An exhibitor (or competitor) whose dog is entered at a Royal Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not knowingly put their dogs' health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. A breach of this Regulation may be referred to the Board for disciplinary action under Royal Kennel Club Rules and Regulations. The use of pinch collars, electronic shock collars, or prong collars, is not permitted at any field trial licensed by the Royal Kennel Club. This shall apply at the venue or within the precincts of the trial.

DOGS IN CARS ON HOT DAYS

Your dog is vulnerable and AT RISK if left in a vehicle in high temperatures and even on days considered as slightly warm. Please take care of your dog(s). If your dog is found to be at risk forcible entry to your vehicle may be necessary without liability for any damage caused.

DEFINITION:

All Aged

A stake which is open to all dogs of a specified breed or breeds without restriction as to their age, but which may be restricted by any other conditions which may be determined by the society subject to the approval of the Board of the Royal Kennel Club.
