Introduction

The Agility Team GB Selection Process is designed to include dogs and handlers competing at an International level. It is designed to be an “Open for All” selection, provided that partnerships have achieved, or are close to achieving, a level that will enable them to compete at international events.

This document sets out the criteria **for qualifying for** the Agility Team GB Tryouts commencing in January 2027.

The rules and regulations of the qualification and Tryout process will be announced by the end of November 2026

Eligibility for Try Outs 2027

ALL dogs in ALL heights trying out for Agility Team GB must have **obtained an official FCI Championship BEFORE 26th JANUARY 2027.**

EO/AWC

Achieve at least one of the following between April 1 2026, and November 1 2026.

- An IQ Class win, achieved in the dog's FCI height category.
- An IQ Top Two Overall placement achieved in the dog's FCI height category.
- 2026 AWC or EO Team member who competed, or was a travelling reserve, at the 2026 EO or AWC.
- 2026 JAO Team member who competed, or was a travelling reserve, at the 2026 JAO who is no longer eligible for JAO 2027 due to age.

All qualifying results must be achieved in the dog's FCI height category. The only exception to this rule will be if a dog has had a GB height classification before competing in the IQs, but the subsequent FCI measure differs; in that case, the dog will be allowed to change height and run at its FCI height in the Try Out process.

To be eligible to attend the Agility Team GB Try Out process in 2027, **ALL partnerships MUST compete** (run both classes) **at a minimum of two (2) International Qualifiers** during the qualification dates.

In addition, the Open Showcase will be held on 30th January 2027 (if entry pertains, this may extend to include 29 January 2027). This will have automatic Win On Places to qualify for the 2027 Try Out Process. (Exact details to be announced in the OSC schedule released at the end of 2026).

To be eligible to enter the 2027 Open Showcase, one of the following is required,

- The dog's date of birth must be after 31st July 2023
- Provide evidence that the partnership was unable to compete in Agility from April through September 2026. (i.e. a veterinary letter or a doctor's letter)
- Partnerships must have competed at a minimum of FOUR International Qualifiers (run both classes) in 2026.

(Please note that if partnerships do not meet one of the above criteria, they are ineligible to enter the OSC. If they do enter and are ineligible, they will not be permitted to run and will not be eligible for a refund.)

In addition, the Agility Team GB Management may select dogs that have not met the above criteria to join the process due to extenuating circumstances, as determined by the management team or based on results from the Open Showcase 2027.

Juniors

Handler requirements;

- 2009 or later date of birth.
- Young Royal Kennel Club Member.

Who has achieved at least one of the following:

- Qualified for the Young Royal Kennel Club Agility Dog of the Year Semi-Finalist 2027, who competes at Grade 2 or above by 1st October 2026 and has achieved 20 Agility Warrant points.
- 2026 Junior or Adult Team member who competed at the 2026 JAO, EO or AWC, or was a travelling reserve.
- Junior Open Showcase 2027 Qualifying result (to be announced in the OSC schedule released at the end of 2026)



All qualifying results must be achieved in the dog's FCI height category. The only exception to this rule will be if a dog has had a GB height classification before qualifying for the ADOTY 2027 Semi Final, but the subsequent FCI measure differs; in that case, the dog will be allowed to change height and run at its FCI height in the Try Out process.

In addition, the Agility Team GB Management may select dogs who have not met the above criteria to join the process due to extenuating circumstances as determined by the management team.

Additional Information

The Agility Team GB Management reserves the right to invite additional dogs to enter the Try-Out Process.

ALL dogs in ALL heights trying out for Agility Team GB must have **obtained an official FCI Championship measure BEFORE 26th JANUARY 2027.**

If your dog has not attended an FCI Championship and received a measure there, then you must attend the measuring on the weekend of 23 and 24 January 2027.
