Entries have opened for Crufts 2026, which is taking place at the NEC in Birmingham from Thursday 5 – Sunday 8 March this year. Tickets are also now on sale via crufts.org.uk.

Crufts 2026 will showcase over 200 pedigree breeds, beginning with the Working and Pastoral groups on Thursday 5 March, Terrier and Hound groups on Friday 6 March, Utility and

Toy on Saturday 7 March and concluding with the Gundog group on Sunday 8 March. Elsewhere, the Junior Warrant final and Breeders competition will also

take place on the Thursday, and the Joe Cartledge Memorial International Junior Handling competition and Vulnerable Breed final on the Friday.

Last year saw over 18,500 dogs competing for Best in Show, with the most overseas dogs entered than ever before - 3,952 dogs from 50 countries. Crufts 2026 will, for the first time, see the addition of Hall 8 as the brand-new home of the Young Kennel Club (YKC) - a vibrant and inspiring space dedicated to nurturing the next generation of dog lovers and handlers. The new hall will also play host to brand-new dog grooming competitions, showcasing the artistry and precision of top dog grooming talent from all over the world.

In the popular Discover Dogs zone, visitors can meet and learn about over 200 breeds - including three newly-recognised breeds on the Imported Breed Register - Hungarian Mudi, Icelandic Sheepdog and Pyrenean Mastiff. Over in the breed rings, Bolognese, Coton de Tulear, German Pinscher and Japanese Akita Inu have Challenge Certificates (CCs) for the first time while Russian Toy exhibitors have breed classes scheduled for the first time.

To enter Crufts 2026, or to find out more about qualification, visit crufts.org.uk/crufts-entries. Postal entries close on 5 January 2026 and online entries close on 19 January 2026. The schedule is available through Fosse Daya Systems Ltd and the Royal Kennel Club would like to thank Fosse Data for running Crufts entries. Exhibitors are asked to note that digital catalogues will be available once again this year. However, there will be the option to order a printed version if preferred, but they must be pre ordered on the entry form and collected at the show by 12 noon on the day they are valid.

The Royal Kennel Club is also calling for anyone competing at Crufts - in any activity or discipline - to help to promote the benefits of dog ownership, dogs in society and taking part in canine activities. The organisation is looking for inspiring dogs and owners with interesting stories that it can communicate to the media in the run up to Crufts and during the show itself. To give competitors at Crufts the potential opportunity to tell their dog's story to the wider world, the Royal Kennel Club has set up an online form, which can be filled in by visiting crufts.org.uk/crufts-stories/

Examples of stories that might be of interest are:

- Dogs that have changed their owners' lives, or positively impacted the lives of others
- Dogs and/or owners or handlers that have overcome the odds
- Dogs with jobs outside of the show ring, or the canine activity they take part in
- Oldest and youngest Crufts competitors
- Two or more generations of the same family competing at Crufts
- A family with a very long association with Crufts
- Competitors who found love through their dog

Tom Mather, Crufts Chairman, commented: “Every year we look for remarkable stories that show the wide range of people who enjoy taking part in dog showing and the many other canine activities and disciplines, to showcase the impact that dogs have on our lives and to share some amazing stories of what goes on outside of the show ring.

“If you are competing at Crufts 2026 and have a good story to tell or an interesting history with Crufts that you are happy to be

shared with the public, then let us know by filling out the online form and help us to show the world just how wonderful our dogs are.”

Across the four days of the show, Crufts welcomes nearly 20,000 dogs, 155,000 people and sees over 8 million TV viewers tune into the Channel 4, More4 and All4 broadcast. All the main arena action is also live streamed on the official Crufts YouTube channel.

Crufts 2026 will introduce a two-day weekday ticket (valid for Thursday and Friday), giving visitors even more time to explore the show, alongside a Fast-Track Arena seating ticket, available for Friday or Saturday, which includes reserved seating in the main arena for unbeatable views of the action - without the queues.

Nominations open for Young Person of the Year Award

Our annual award celebrates young people who are transforming the lives of others, recognising those who are going above and beyond or overcoming huge challenges to demonstrate their love of dogs, and encourage others to become a part the dog world.

They could be giving up their time to mentor other young people, training dogs, fundraising or competing. Whatever they are doing, they have one thing in common - a desire to make a difference and improve the lives of dogs.

Young Person of the Year Award

Recognising outstanding Young Kennel Club members, and their dogs, who are making a difference to improve the lives of their canine companions.

Nomination categories for 2026:

- **Inspiration:** Awarded to a young person and their dog who have inspired others either through their own personal journey or have made a significant positive impact in their community.

- **Teamwork:** Awarded to an inspirational partnership or team of members and their canine companions that have overcome challenges to achieve together.
- **Talent:** Awarded to a young handler or trainer who has shown exceptional skill and dedication in competing or training their dog.
- **Creative:** Awarded to a young person who has creatively showcased their love of dogs through art, photography, writing, or social media.
- **Awareness:** Awarded to a young person who actively promotes animal welfare or involvement in animal rescue or shelter work, and awareness campaigns.

How to nominate:

Nominations are open online now and the closing date for submissions is 30 January 2026. Each member may be nominated in one category only, and self-nominations are not permitted. All nominees must be current members of the Young Kennel Club.

Category winners will be announced early in 2026, after which the public will have the opportunity to vote for the overall YKC Young Person of the Year. The winners of each category will be invited to Crufts 2026, where the overall award winner will be revealed. The winner will receive £200 thanks to a donation from the Kennel Club Educational Trust. Each category winner will be awarded £100.

Launch of Innate Health Assessment and development of Royal Kennel Club nose to tail

On Tuesday 18 November the All-Party Parliamentary Group for Animal Welfare (APGAW), launched the Innate Health Assessment (IHA), a voluntary conformational programme aimed towards licenced breeders.

The Innate Health Assessment (IHA) is an assessment of conformation that includes ten visible criteria, with dogs that score at least 8/10 awarded a pass. The assessment will be voluntary, and licensed breeders will be asked to self-assess their own dogs using the Innate Health Assessment process. The Royal Kennel Club is not requiring any owners or breeders to complete the assessment: as stated it is voluntary.

The Royal Kennel Club is committed to the principle that all dogs should have a body shape that enables them to lead a good quality of life. We therefore support the principle of initiatives such as the work of the All-Party Parliamentary Group for Animal Welfare (APGAW) and the Innate Health Assessment (IHA).

However, while we are supportive of the principles of Innate Health, we believe that for our pedigree breeder community, veterinary involvement is crucial to ensure a consistent and robust way of assessing conformation and recording data to help breeders demonstrate progress. We are therefore developing a robust, nose-to-tail veterinary assessment, which builds on over a decade of prior work with breeders committed to ensuring a healthier future for dogs

It is worth noting that, while we have been involved in the development of the IHA in an advisory capacity, having been invited by APGAW to join a working group in 2023, the assessment criteria were not selected by us, and we have in fact raised concerns on several occasions about how these criteria may not best support breeders in our community.

At the beginning of 2026 we will be launching our new Future for Dog Breeding report. This report will



introduce our new 'Breeding for Health Framework'. A central aim of this framework is that every dog should have a body shape that allows it to lead a normal life and to display normal canine behaviour.

We will be keeping our communities updated with how this initiative progresses throughout 2026 and be coming to Breed Health Co-ordinators for each breed's insights and thoughts, particularly to those who run their own breed club health scheme already, as we appreciate they will have details and knowledge in this area that we can integrate into this project.

We have already held a drop-in session for Breed Health Co-ordinators to attend and are now in the process of the next steps of developing the RKC Nose to tail initiative, which as mentioned above will draw on the expertise and input of our breed communities. There will be more to

be announced in this space over the coming weeks, with Breed Health Co-ordinators, licenced breeders and vets to be brought into focus group sessions to help us build a tool that will be beneficial and practical across our communities. Whilst the assessment is being managed independently of the Royal Kennel Club, our Public Affairs and Health Team can feedback from our communities to APGAW, so we look forward to bringing additional perspectives to this area of canine health.
