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RKC sets out future direction at landmark first AGM under new Royal identity

The Royal Kennel Club (RKC) set out its future direction and ongoing organisational transformation at its Annual General Meeting (AGM) held on Tuesday 16 June 2026 at Friends House in London. The meeting marked the first AGM since the organisation began using its Royal prefix.

Making his inaugural address at an AGM as Chairman of the Royal Kennel Club, Ian Seath opened the proceedings, thanking members for attending in person and for participating in a pre-AGM online Q&A session held earlier in the month.

In his speech, Ian reflected on the organisation's long-standing role in supporting the relationship between people and dogs, noting that this remains central to the Royal Kennel Club's purpose. He also spoke about his three priorities during his year as Chairman: communication improvements, financial turnaround and governance reforms.

He called on members to continue working collaboratively, highlighting the importance of respect, sportsmanship, and constructive engagement across the organisation. He referenced the Sportsmanship Pledge, introduced in November 2025 at the SGM, as part of ongoing efforts to promote positive conduct within the community.

Ian also emphasised the need for the organisation to embrace change in order to ensure long-term sustainability, while maintaining a shared focus on dog health, wellbeing, and sporting activities.



He concluded: "If we can focus on our shared love for dogs and work together in their service, I am confident that we can meet any challenge ahead. By embracing change, supporting one another, and upholding the values of sportsmanship and respect, we can build a strong and sustainable future for the Royal Kennel Club and the wider canine community."

Chief Executive of the Royal Kennel Club, Jannine Edgar, provided an overview of progress across the organisation over the past year,

including the publication of the 2025 Annual Report, the appointment of Charlotte McNamara as Chief Canine Wellbeing and Engagement Officer, and the formal introduction of the Royal Kennel Club identity following the granting of the Royal prefix by His Majesty King Charles III.

She highlighted the rollout of the “At Their Service” campaign supporting the new identity, alongside improvements to the Petlog microchipping reunification service, which have contributed to increased reunifications of lost dogs with their owners.

Looking ahead, Jannine outlined priorities around broadening engagement with dog owners through initiatives such as Crufts Club, which has the potential to reach 75% of the dog-owning British public that currently do not engage with RKC. The service, which launched in 2026, aims to encourage more people to get involved at a grassroots level, whether that’s by generating interest in pedigree dogs, accelerating participation in activities, or increasing attendance at year-round events.

Jannine also highlighted the continued growth across canine activities, including a 52% increase in applications to the Young Royal Kennel Club Team GB agility programme and continued expansion across competitive disciplines.

Jannine said the organisation’s focus remains on pedigree dogs, strengthening services and engagement while supporting dog health, wellbeing, and participation at all levels.

Reflecting on the AGM, Jannine said: “The past year has demonstrated the progress we can make when we combine our heritage and expertise with a willingness to evolve. From improving services for dog owners and breeders to engaging new audiences through initiatives such as Crufts Club, we are creating new opportunities to strengthen and grow our community.

“As we look ahead, our focus remains on building a sustainable future that enables us to continue supporting dog health, wellbeing, and canine activities at every level. We are excited about the opportunities ahead and grateful to our members for their ongoing support and advocacy.”

The AGM also spotlighted the success of Crufts, with Crufts Chairman, Tom Mather, providing an overview of the 2026 event, which attracted more than 19,000 entries and over 155,000 visitors. Tom also celebrated the success of the introduction of Hall 8 which “provided a valuable new dimension to the show [...] serving as the home of the Young Royal Kennel Club.” He went on to thank all the contributors who make Crufts happen from the sponsors to the volunteers, adding “I salute all the exhibitors and their marvellous dogs.”

Ian Seath closed the AGM by thanking the attendees for their participation in the discussion and invited members back to Clarges Street for afternoon tea.

Art Gallery showcases female artists who turned dog portraiture into a profession

Among the most notable works on display are a pastel portrait of Dookie, Queen Elizabeth II's first corgi, by Lucy Dawson, as well as works by Frances Fairman and Anne Zoutsos, whose portrait of the Crufts 2025 Best in Show entered the RKC collection earlier this year.

The exhibition 'Leaders of the Pack: The Women of the Royal Kennel Club Art Collection' opened on Wednesday 10 June 2026 at the RKC gallery at 10 Clarges Street, Mayfair, bringing together over 120 works by more than 100 female artists, women who largely faced exclusion from formal art training and gallery representation, yet built remarkable professional careers regardless. Spanning painting, sculpture, drawing, printmaking and medals, the works trace both how women turned to canine portraiture to carve a professional path, and the arc of female emancipation in Britain from the Victorian era to the present day.

At a moment when institutions across the cultural arts are actively reappraising the women written out of art history, the RKC Art Gallery has been proudly preserving their work for decades. With a fifty-fifty split of male to female artists in the collection, the gallery is leading the way for gender parity compared to others in the field; in 2022, researchers at Cambridge University found that only seven percent of art in top UK galleries was by female artists, with the Tate Modern's collection sitting at less than forty percent and the National Gallery's at roughly one percent.¹

'Leaders of the Pack: The Women of the Royal Kennel Club Art Collection' features art by masters in their field, such

as Maud Earl (1863–1943). Earl was one of the most celebrated animal painters of her generation, with more than 125 works in the RKC collection charting the evolution of her style across a six-decade career. Lilian Cheviot and Fanny Moody are also included; both artists supported themselves entirely through dog art commissions, speaking to the appetite for canine portraiture in that era and to the determination of women who built careers entirely on their own terms.

The exhibition is not exclusively a historical survey. Anne Zoutsos,

a practising artist for more than 30 years whose work is held in the Royal Collection Trust, contributed a portrait of Crufts 2025 Best in Show winner Miuccia, Ch/Int/Multi Ch Una Donna Che Conta. A print of the Whippet entered the RKC collection in March 2026, proof that the tradition these women established is very much alive.

Jannine Edgar, Chief Executive at the Royal Kennel Club said: “We are incredibly proud to open ‘Leaders of the Pack’ and shine a light on the remarkable women represented in the Royal Kennel Club collection. These artists built successful careers, developed distinctive creative voices and helped shape the history of canine portraiture across three centuries.

“It is a wonderfully uplifting exhibition filled with character, charm and exceptional artistry, and we are delighted to welcome visitors (and their dogs!) to discover this hidden part of British art history.”

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Whippets surge in popularity as UK registrations jump 18% in early 2026

As the Whippet rises up the ranks in registrations, Royal Kennel Club's Q1 2026 data reveals some surprising movement in the top 15 breeds.

The Royal Kennel Club's data, covering litters registered throughout the first quarter of 2026, shows the top ten breeds remain the same with our beloved retrievers retaining their positions. However, the picture outside the top ten is markedly different, with Whippets now one of Britain's most-chosen dogs.

Following its Best in Show win at Crufts 2025, the breed now sits within the top fifteen with an 18% year-on-year increase. The hound has built up a loyal following across the UK, including celebrity owners such as Jennifer Saunders, Laura Jackson, Kit Harrington, and Nathaniel Parker.

Once referred to as 'the greyhound in miniature', this sighthound was originally bred from Greyhounds. Dating back to the Middle Ages, the Whippet has long been admired for its speed, elegance, and gentle temperament. Historically used for hunting small game in the mining communities of the North and Wales, the breed has since evolved into one of the UK's most popular family companions. Despite their athletic reputation, Whippets are known for being affectionate, adaptable, and surprisingly low maintenance, requiring only around an hour of exercise a day and minimal grooming. Their sleek physique combined with a calm nature at home and lifespan of up to 12 years on average, has helped fuel their growing popularity among both city and countryside dog owners.

In other breeds, RKC registrations of French Bulldogs fell 37% year-on-year,

while Bulldog registrations dropped 34% and Pug registrations declined by 43%. While these breeds had seen a significant surge in popularity in recent years, the Royal Kennel Club believes the decrease reflects growing awareness around responsible breeding and ownership. Through initiatives such as its Respiratory Function Grading Scheme, developed with the University of Cambridge, the RKC has continued to prioritise health-led breeding decisions to help improve the future welfare of brachycephalic breeds.

Meanwhile, the Labrador Retriever remains by far the most registered dog on the list, followed by the Cocker Spaniel. Both breeds are family-loving, friendly and fiercely loyal, reflecting how many families in the UK feel their home isn't complete without a dog.

Charlotte McNamara, Chief Canine

and Wellbeing Officer at the Royal Kennel Club, said: "These early figures for 2026 tell us something important about how Britain's relationship with dogs is evolving. Owners are becoming more considered in their decision making, taking the time to understand which breeds genuinely suit their lifestyle before bringing a dog home which is exactly what we've always encouraged.

"We're also incredibly grateful to everyone who registers their puppies with the Royal Kennel Club. Registration not only helps owners better understand their dog's parent's health history and lineage, but it also allows us to build a clearer picture of changing trends across the UK's dog population. Insights like these help inform conversations around breeding, wellbeing, and long-term canine welfare for generations to come."

One debut shower who started from Have A Go was Bernadetta Rojowska, 41, who qualified at the Three Counties show in 2025. The full-time mum of three from Staffordshire is also the proud owner of three Samoyeds and she always wanted to get into showing, even though she initially knew nothing about it. After she and her dog, Ozzie, went on to win Reserve Best Puppy in Show at Stafford & District Canine Society in September 2025 and they even came third at the Have A Go final at Crufts 2026.

Bernadetta said: "Have A Go felt like the perfect opportunity to gain experience, have fun and maybe get confirmation that I was capable of being a handler myself. Ozzie was still very much a puppy – full of energy

and acting more like a kangaroo than a show dog – but somehow we did it and qualified for Crufts. It was an amazing experience.

"One of the best parts of showing has been the friendships. I've met amazing people through the show ring and I can always count on their advice, feedback and support. Celebrating each other's wins and helping each other through the tough days makes the experience even more special.

"For anyone considering showing, make it fun and do it for yourself and your dog. Don't focus too much on winning – enjoy the experience, learn and make memories together. If you and your dog are having fun, you've already won."

Amendment to Breed Standards

At its recent meeting the Board approved the following amendments:

AFFENPINSCHER

GENERAL APPEARANCE Rough coated, sturdy in build with a mischievous monkey-like expression. Although small, not delicate in any way. **Never stylised or sculptured.**

COAT Correct coat needs no trimming, rough and harsh in texture, short and dense on some parts of the body and shaggy on others. In particular, longer on shoulders, neck and head where loose shaggy hair stands away from skull framing eyes, nose and chin giving the desired monkey-like appearance. **Stylised or sculptured presentation highly undesirable.**

(Amendments in bold)

JAPANESE AKITA INU

BRIEF HISTORICAL SUMMARY The Akita Inu is the original Akita as found in Japan and has remained remarkably unchanged for centuries. The Japanese Akita Inu originated in the Tohoku area of Japan, which sits below the Hokkaido Island. Several names have been used in describing the Akita depending on the region of origin, such as Odate-Inu, and Kazuno-Inu from the Northern Regions. Collectively they were known as 'Regional Dogs'. Those living in towns and used for fighting were known as 'Kuwae-Inu', while others used for hunting in the countryside were known as 'Matagi-Inu'. The dogs were quite similar in style. They were all Japanese dogs, which had been bred in these areas since ancient times. These were the ancestors of today's Akita.

GENERAL APPEARANCE Large well-balanced, sturdily built dog of Spitz type, **with substance.** Very slightly longer than high. **Stand off coat with brilliant colours and defined markings.** Sexes are clearly distinguishable from each other.

Important Proportions Length from point of shoulder to point of buttock slightly greater than height at withers, as 11:10. Females may be slightly longer. **Skull to muzzle proportions 3:2**

CHARACTERISTICS Alert and agile. Thick triangular ears pricked and inclined forward. Dark eyes, set and shaped to give a distinctive appearance. Stand off coat with brilliant colours and defined markings. Tightly curled tail.

TEMPERAMENT Alert and agile. Bold, dignified, composed character. Indifferent to strangers. **Never nervous.**

HEAD AND SKULL When viewed from the front, the head appears rounded due to well-developed cheeks. From above, the head appears as a blunt triangle. Broad skull, flat and free from wrinkle. Defined stop and distinct furrow. Skull to muzzle proportions 3:2. **Muzzle strong with broad base, tapering but not pointed, Nasal bridge straight.** Nose large and black except in white dogs where flesh coloured nose is acceptable. Lips tight with dark pigment.

EYES Relatively small, placed moderately apart, almost triangular in shape due to the rising of the outer eye corner, dark brown and obliquely set. Eye rims dark and tight.

EARS Thick, triangular and slightly hooded, with rounded tips. **Relatively** small, set moderately well apart, pricked and inclining forward. Closely following the line of the neck **in profile.**

MOUTH Strong jaws with a perfect regular and complete scissor bite, i.e. upper teeth closely

overlapping lower teeth and set square to the jaws. Full dentition and well-developed teeth.

NECK Thick and muscular, of moderate length, without dewlap. Pronounced crest blending with back of skull.

FOREQUARTERS Shoulders moderately laid back with well developed muscles. Elbows set close to chest. Forelegs well boned and straight when viewed from the front. Pasterns slightly sloping.

BODY Length from point of shoulder to point of buttock slightly greater than height at withers, as 11:10. Females may be slightly longer. **Firm,** level back. Chest deep with well-developed forechest. Moderately sprung rib cage with well-defined tuck up. Short coupled with broad and muscular loin.

HINDQUARTERS Strong with well developed muscles. Broad thighs, moderate angulation. **Firm hocks, well let down, turning neither in nor out.**

FEET Round, arched and tight with thick pads. Turning neither in nor out.

TAIL Strong at root, set on high. Thick, full and of good length. Tightly curled over the back **to either side.** Uncurled tail highly undesirable.

GAIT AND MOVEMENT Powerful and resilient, moderate length of stride providing for an efficient, rhythmic gait, converging towards the centre line at speed. Stilted or extended gait undesirable.

COAT Outer coat coarse, stand-off and straight. Slightly longer at withers and rump. More profuse on tail. Undercoat soft and dense. **Ruff or feathering undesirable.**

COLOUR Red fawn, with whitish urajiro markings. Sesame: red fawn, guard hairs with black tips, with whitish urajiro markings.

Brindle: defined striping, evenly distributed, with greyish urajiro markings. White markings desirable around nose, on chest, feet and tip of tail.

White markings on back of neck tolerated in red fawn, sesame and brindle.

White: Pure white in colour, with no urajiro markings visible.

(Urajiro: a defined pattern of markings and must appear on sides of muzzle, on cheeks and chest, on underside of jaw, neck, body and tail and the inside of legs. These markings must blend gradually with the main coat colour and not extend above the elbow or hock.)

Any other colour or combination of colours unacceptable.

HEIGHT Height at withers: Dogs 64-70cms (25¼-27½ ins); bitches 58-64cms (22¾-25¼ ins).

FAULTS Any departure from the foregoing points should be considered a fault and the seriousness with which the fault should be regarded should be in exact proportion to its degree and its effect upon the health and welfare of the dog.

NOTE Male animals should have two apparently normal testicles fully descended into the scrotum

Recognition of new breed

Silken Windhound

At its recent meeting, the Board granted recognition of the Silken Windhound on the Imported Breed Register, classified in the Hound Group. This is with effect from 1 October 2026. Until such time as a Royal Kennel Club interim breed standard has been published, the breed is not eligible to compete at Royal Kennel Club licensed breed shows.

Change of title

INITIAL CONSIDERATION

At its meeting in April 2026, the Shows Executive Committee approved for advertisement the following Change of Title application:

FROM: SOUTH OF SCOTLAND GSD & ALL BREEDS TRAINING CLUB

TO: SOUTH OF SCOTLAND GSD CLUB

De-registration of title

The Weimaraner Association has been de-registered by the Royal Kennel Club under Regulation C6. The de-registration became effective from 12 May 2026. An Appeals Tribunal was held as part of the process, and a summary of the outcome is given below.

- The Appeals Tribunal noted the extensive correspondence between the Weimaraner Association and the RKC during 2025-26. The Tribunal noted that the arguments being articulated at the hearing by the Association for the case against de-registration rested upon the following three threads:
 - that the RKC had guided and advised that Rule 19 in the Association's constitution gave the ground and basis for the removal of the five respective members without the caveat that Rule 13d and the expulsion process via an SGM should be deployed;
 - that the successive procedural flaws by the RKC as pointed out and subject to separate Rule A11 complaints should mean that the Weimaraner Association's procedural issues should be treated in a comparable manner and should not form the rationale and basis for de-registration; and
 - that the earlier suspension of the Weimaraner Association was against natural justice and the precepts as expounded by Mr Justice Cooke; Colgan v The Kennel Club 2001.
- The nub of the matter was the removal of five Weimaraner Association members under Rule 19 of the Association's constitution, for breaches of Data Protection requirements. This was a committee decision, and the removal of members was not done via the prescribed SGM expulsion route (Rule 13 of the Association constitution) to request the membership to review and vote by a 2/3 majority to confirm such expulsions.
- It is the Association's view that the RKC led it to believe, in a letter of 21 March 2025, that it was appropriate for the committee to use Rule 19 solely to remove members and need not hold an expulsion SGM.
- The Tribunal noted that in letters from the RKC to the Association of 7 February; 21 March; 13 May; 29 May and 9 June 2025, the RKC consistently advocated and urged that the constitutional route needed to be used for expulsion of members, via an SGM (and latterly that the members should therefore be reinstated and the proper process undertaken).
- The Tribunal view was that there had been a continual and wrongful reliance on the letter of 21 March 2025 and this did not absolve the Association from not following its constitution. This position resulted firstly in a suspension measure and finally the directive to de-register by the RKC Board.
- It is noted that the Information Commissioner's Office [ICO] issued guidance to the Association

about the issues over General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and some of the five expelled members. This was guidance with options.

7. The Tribunal's view was that the only and contractual way to remove members, other than a default on subscription payment, should be via an SGM process and with membership mandate to remove members.
8. The Tribunal reluctantly found itself with no option but to confirm and endorse the decision of the Board and that the Weimaraner Association should be de-registered.
9. It was the view of the Tribunal that this situation should have been capable of resolution at an early stage with the parties involved finding a sensible route through entrenched positions and navigating personal differences.
10. It was also the Appeal Tribunal's view that the Association has not managed the situation with a sufficient degree of awareness of how to communicate in an appropriate and effective way. The communications have at times been difficult to work through and the Tribunal has spent a considerable time doing so.
11. The RKC has been at pains to support where possible. It is always neutral and non-preferential.
12. The Association will now need to find an orderly way to disengage from the RKC. It does not mean the Association ceases to exist, but it will no longer be recognised by the RKC as a registered society.

Challenge Certificate Allocation Review 2029-2032

The Royal Kennel Club is commencing its review of Challenge Certificate (CC) allocation for 2029-2032 and invites breed clubs to submit any comments or suggestions regarding current CC allocations within their breed.

In addition, any breed club that does not currently hold CC status but wishes to be considered for future CC allocations is invited to contact the Royal Kennel Club and provide supporting information for consideration as part of the review process.

Breed clubs are asked to send their recommendations and supporting information to rsn@royalkennelclub.com by the 31st July.

The Royal Kennel Club would also like to remind breed clubs that, in accordance with current requirements, a Breed Appreciation Day (BAD) or Multi-Choice Examination (MCE) must be held at least once every two years to ensure ongoing educational opportunities for judges and exhibitors within the breed.
