year's Championship. The Winner of the 94th Kennel Club Cocker Spaniel Championship is eligible to compete without qualifying. The Winner of the

2025/26 Irish Cocker Spaniel Championship is eligible to compete.

All qualified dogs <u>must</u> be entered into the Championship by the owner, either via Fosse Data or by returning a paper entry form accompanied by payment.

DRAW: By the Fosse System initiated by The Kennel Club at **1pm on Monday 15 December**

All qualified dogs will run in the Championship. The draw is to determine the running order. For stakes taking place after 15th December 2025 the name of the Society holding the stake will be listed in the Draw.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. Dogs entered at Kennel Club Licensed Field Trials must be registered at The Kennel Club in accordance with Kennel Club Regulations for Classification and Registration B.
- 2. The Kennel Club reserves the right to refuse any entry.
- 3. Substitution of dogs is **not** permitted.
- 4. All dogs resident outside the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to Compete (ATC) number before entry to the Championship can be made.
- 5. Should circumstances so dictate, the Society, in consultation with the judges, may alter arrangements as necessary. Such changes and the circumstances surrounding them will be reported to The Kennel Club.
- 6. No modification may be made to the schedule after publication except by permission of The Kennel Club, followed by advertisement in appropriate journals if time permits before the closing of entries.
- 7. Judges at a Trial are prohibited from entering a dog which is recorded in their ownership or part ownership.
- 8. Videography and photography will only be permitted with the express agreement of the Chief Steward and the Host.

9. Welfare of Dogs

A competitor whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not knowingly put their dogs' health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. A breach of this Regulation may be referred to the Board for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rules and Regulations. The use of pinch collars, electronic shock collars, or prong collars, is not permitted at any field trial licensed by the Kennel Club. This shall apply at the venue or within the precincts of the trial

10. Social Media must not be used when on the Championship ground, location tagging must be removed on images.

Any photography / videography must be with the permission of the Chief Steward only.

POSTPONEMENT OR CANCELLATION OF EVENTS

We reserve the right to amend and reschedule the date of the Championship or cancel where we need to do so in exceptional circumstances which are beyond the control of The Kennel Club. In the event of a postponement of the Championship the entry fees will be transferred to the postponed date. The Kennel Club will have no further liability whatsoever, including (but not limited to) any direct or indirect consequential loss or damage, loss of enjoyment or travel or accommodation costs.
