**Royal Kennel Club Agility Regulations H paragraph 19 – Minimum judging experience required for Agility Championship Large / Intermediate / Medium / Small Dog at Championship Agility Shows**

On application for a person’s first appointment to judge the Championship Agility Class the minimum conditions which apply are:-

- 1) The person must have:
  - a minimum of 5 years’ experience of competing at Royal Kennel Club licensed agility shows, and
  - a minimum of 5 years’ experience of judging at Royal Kennel Club licensed agility shows, and
  - have judged at a minimum of 10 licensed agility shows over the previous 3 years including standard classes in each height category which must include grade 7, class size and geographical distribution of judging appointments will be a consideration, and
  - have judged Royal Kennel Club qualifiers in each height category for Crufts, Discover Dogs, or the Royal Kennel Club Agility Stakes (excluding YKC classes) at a minimum of 2 licensed agility shows, and
  - have handled a dog competitively at grade 6 or 7, and
  - have completed and passed an agility judges examination on the Royal Kennel Club Academy prior to attending a Royal Kennel Club Judges Seminar, and
  - have attended a Royal Kennel Club Agility Judges Seminar and passed the assessment within the last 5 years
- 2) The person must have been assessed when judging grade 6 or grade 7 Agility classes before being approved for their first Championship appointment; details of future judging appointments should be provided on this form to enable the Royal Kennel Club to arrange an assessment.

NOTE: A person approved to judge a Championship Agility Certificate may not judge another Championship Agility Certificate at the same height category within a period of six calendar months.
